Funding Opportunities

- 1. Grants for unpaid public service internships**
 - These grants, up to \$3500, will allow LEDA community members to participate in unpaid internships
- 2. Micro-grants for paid public service internships**
 - These micro-grants, up to \$1000, will help LEDA community members offset the cost of participating in a paid public service internship

Eligibility

✓ **LEDA Scholars and Career Fellows in good standing**

Current undergraduate and graduate students

✓ Juniors and Seniors will receive priority. Your internship must be at least 6 weeks and at a public service organization in the United States during the summer of 2022. Proof of offer must be provided in your application and you must accept your internship offer prior to funds being disbursed.

Provide proof that the internship is unpaid

✓ To be considered for the Grant (but not a micro-grant)

Other Requirements

LEDA Community members selected must:

- Remain in good standing with their employer throughout their term
- Meet with LEDA Staff, including completing surveys and participation in a minimum of three meetings
- Complete required LEDA surveys throughout their internship

Community members who violate their terms of employment or do not comply with LEDA's additional requirements will be asked to pay back their stipend at a prorated rate dependent on the dates of their internship.
